


Fisher Families,

I joined the South Redford School District in August 2008 and worked for the past three years at Thurston High School. Before I came to the district, I worked in Flint, Michigan at a K-8 school for 5 years as a School Social Worker.

We had a very informational January PTO meeting! Our Fundraising officers reviewed the results of the last few fundraisers (these can be viewed on the Fundraising Up-

date page in this newsletter) and presented a graphic diagram regarding our Fundraising goals, plans, and results so far. It was decided to link this page onto our PTO website so our families could have a better understanding of PTO fundraising. A motion was passed to donate \$250 to Vandenburg Elementary towards the costs of their Martin Luther King Day Celebration. An idea of having a MOM -to-MOM sale was suggested and dates are being looked into. It was confirmed that the Book Fair would be occurring during conferences at the end of February/beginning of March. Other upcoming events were discussed including Skate Night, (Feb 24) Bingo for Books (Feb 10th) and a Movie Night (March date TBA). 4th Grade teacher, Kyle Martin and Principal Amy Davidson attended the meeting as staff liaisons. Mr. Martin thanked the PTO for the Holiday Goodie Bags filled with classroom supplies that were gifted to the teachers before the holiday break. He also spoke about the two Fisher staff organized Family Nights: Math Night (Feb 27th) and Reading Night (Redford Library, March 19th). He asked for suggestions regarding what parents would like to see at these family events and for support from the PTO in helping set up for the events. Mrs. Davidson informed the PTO that the school recently received a check for \$400 from Box Tops for Education! She encourages all to continue to send them in from home! It was noted that a group of parents have begun preparations for the 4th and 5th Grade Battle of the Books. A motion for the PTO to donate \$250 to
